EADV SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION FORM

Instructions to applicants:

Please read these instructions carefully before filling in the form. Only forms that are properly completed and sent within the deadline will be considered. It is the applicant's responsibility to follow the criteria for scholarship application and ensure that the information provided in the application form is truthful and accurate. The applicant has to mention clearly in the list of publication if her/his surname has changed over her/his training/publication period.

Evaluation of EADV scholarship applications is made on the basis of an objective assessment of the applicant's scientific activities. The list of publications has to be presented in <u>numerical</u> order (i.e. 1..., 2..., 3...,...). Points are awarded according to the following scoring system:

- ◆ International journal publications (Publications in international peer reviewed journals) and chapters in international books – 3 points
- ◆ Web publications, national book contributions and national journal publications (Contributions in books and web publications as well as publications in scientific peer reviewed journals of the same country of origin as the applicant) – 2 points
- ♦ Oral and poster presentations 1 point

A minimum of 5 points are required to win a scholarship.

When completing the scholarship application form description of the applicant's scientific activities should be in Vancouver format, as in the following examples:

Only fully and properly described references will be included in the evaluation process. Only articles and books that have been published (including e-publication) will be accepted. Articles that have been submitted or are 'in press' but have not yet been published by the time of application will not be accepted.

Only presentations made at international, national and regional scientific events will be accepted. Other presentations e.g. at hospital departmental meetings and events organised by pharmaceutical companies will not be accepted. Full details of other authors, title of presentation, full name of conference (avoid abbreviations), venue and dates and whether the presentation was an oral or poster presentation must be given. In case of oral presentations the presentation must have been made personally by the applicant to be accepted and therefore it should be indicated clearly in the application that the presentation was in fact made personally by the applicant. Poster presentations will be given points only if the applicant was the first or last author and only such presentations should be included in the application. In both cases the full list of authors must be provided.

Published abstracts are not awarded points and should not be listed. Active participation in international, national and regional scientific events should be included with 'Oral' or Poster' presentations.
