HOW TO TRAVEL TO BUDAPEST

By Plane

Budapest (Ferihegy) International Airport is the country's largest airport, located about 16 km (10 miles) southeast of the city centre. Ferihegy has two terminals, Terminal 1 and Terminal 2, often called Ferihegy-1 and Ferihegy-2, respectively. Terminal 2 is the hub of the Hungarian national carrier, Malév.

By Train

Budapest has excellent rail connections from Europe. Time to get from Budapest Main Station to the congress venue by tram or by taxi is 10-20 minutes.
